Purpose of the Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to build an educational pathway that leads to further student educational attainment and success.

Admission Requirements for the Receiving Institution

- A. The receiving institution's admissions requirements apply to students who transfer under this agreement.
- B. Students must fulfill all graduation requirements at both institutions.

Transfer of Credits and Credits Required within this Agreement

- A. The receiving institution will accept a minimum of 60 credits from SCC.
- B. Courses will transfer according to the attached Degree Planning Sheet (Addendum).
- C. Minimum total additional credits required at the receiving institution to complete the baccalaureate degree: 60.
- D. Both institutions will honor all existing reverse transfer agreements.

Terms of Agreement and Review

- A. The designees of both SCC and MU will implement the terms of this agreement.
- B. Review of this agreement will be done every three (3) years or more frequently as needed based on updated curriculum.
- C. This agreement will remain in effect until discontinued with written notice by either or both institutions.

- D. Both SCC and MU agree to communicate program changes in writing to avoid disruption to student success. This communication would include a revised Recommended Academic Plan with highlighted changes from the institution reporting the change(s).
- E. MU agrees to provide SCC with both the number and percentage of SCC students who achieve degree completion at MU on an annual basis.
- F. Both SCC and MU agree to communicate with common and respective publics concerning this established agreement between the two institutions.
